Nomination Process

The ACCE Lifetime Achievement Award is open to any person who through his or her life's endeavours has demonstrated a significant and lasting contribution through his or her business efforts towards the betterment of the Chinese Canadian community.

Award nominee can be nominated by his or her peers as well as other Chinese and business associations or organizations. Award recipient is then selected by an independent selection committee chaired by the president of ACCE. The selection committee consists of a number of independent community leaders and selected board members.

The following reference materials are requested to support the nomination:

1. The nominee's current curriculum vitae including a list of the philanthropic or civic organizations to which the nominee belongs or has belonged, or has supported in other ways.
2. The nominator's letter stating concisely and persuasively why the nominee should be selected and making the case as to how the nominee meets the selection criteria stated below.
3. Three letters of support as well as the contact information of the nominee's supporters who are familiar with the nominee's outstanding contributions.
4. Any additional supportive documentation, such as newspaper and magazine articles, or references to journals, publications, and coverage in the electronic media.

Nominations will be compiled through the ACCE head office, and presented for review to the selection committee. All nominees must have been born in Canada or have become naturalized Canadian citizens. Nominees can be selected from any Canadian province or territory and do not have to be of Chinese origin or descent.

An interview with selected nominees will be used as part of the selection criteria, as the award will be based on the nominee's spirit and achievements, as well as their nomination application and supporting documentation.

Nominations can be mailed directly or courier to the Association of Chinese Canadian Entrepreneurs to the address printed on the nomination form or below together with additional supportive documentation, nominee's curriculum vitae, and three letters of support.

Nominations that are submitted by e-mail to awards@acce.ca must be formatted in Microsoft Word. Nominations may not be submitted by fax. All nominations must be received by ACCE no later than December 31, 2010.

Award recipient will be announced during the Chinese Canadian Entrepreneurs Awards Gala on Saturday, April 2, 2011 held at the Hilton Suites in Markham, Ontario.

Selection Criteria for the ACCE Lifetime Achievement Award

All nominations should demonstrate long run and sustained contribution to improving the Chinese Canadian business/overall community through the nominee's:

1. **Vision and Leadership** - The nominee must have attained senior level or leadership initiative over several years in the organizations with which they have been involved by demonstrating application of their experience, vision, insight and leadership qualities.
2. **Business Impact** - The nominee will have had an impact on the Chinese Canadian business/overall community; for example through verifiable economic success, exceptional management expertise, etc.
3. **Humanitarianism** - The nomination will demonstrate the nominee's efforts to further Chinese Canadians' social or economic wellbeing as demonstrated through leadership in philanthropy or in community-based initiatives.
4. **Inspiration and Motivation** - Nominees will have been an inspiration to others, displaying professionalism, a consistently positive and motivating attitude, demonstrated ongoing respect for others, as well as having established a visible and long-term record of accomplishment that merits special recognition.

2011 Selection Process and Time Line

December 31, 2010	- Deadline for nomination application
January 2011	- ACCE selection committee reviews nominations and selects recipient
February 28, 2011	- ACCE Lifetime Achievement award winner is notified
April 2, 2011	- ACCE Lifetime Achievement award winner is announced at Chinese Canadian Entrepreneur Awards Gala
