# Lifetime Achievement Award Dr. David C. Lam, David and Dorothy Lam Foundation



Dr. Lam was born in Hong Kong in 1923. He was brought up in a very successful Chinese household, where his Father, Dr. Lam Chi Fung, was the first President and Vice Chancellor of Hong Kong Baptist College. Known today as the Hong Kong Baptist University. Dr. Lam knew education was a very important part of ones life and without it, success would be limited. He went on to thrive in the world of education and obtained his economics degree from Lingnan University in China, then, his MBA degree from Temple University in Philadelphia. At that time, he discovered he was a candidate for the PHD Program at New York University. In 1954 he completed the advanced management program through Harvard University.

After achieving such academic success, Dr. Lam headed the revival of the went on to have a very accomplished 18 year career in the banking industry as the Director and Chief Manager of Ka Wah Bank Ltd. It was during this time, UBC's botanical gardens.

that he met and married his wife Dorothy and began to raise his family.

In 1967, Dr. Lam left Hong Kong to pursue his dreams in Vancouver, Canada. It was during that first year in Canada that he established the Hong Kong Merchants association of Vancouver, which assists new immigrants from Hong Kong. In 1972, he began a new career as a real estate developer. Today, He is the honourable chairman of Fairchild investments, a division of the Fairchild Group. From 1988 to 94 Dr. Lam became the 25th Lt. Governor of British Columbia and the first Chinese-Canadian to hold the position of the Queens representative in this country. Dr. Lam is an avid gardener and while in office, he spearheaded the revival of the grounds and gardens at the Government offices. And even helped to build a garden center devoted to Asian plants within



Dr. Lam has become a renowned philanthropist, founding the David and Dorothy Lam Foundation which has supported numerous educational, botanical, musical and cultural institutions in B.C. and throughout the world. Some of those are: the Vancouver Opera, Lester B. Pearson College of the Pacific and the educational program SUCCESS.

Dr. Lam has received numerous honorary degrees from across Canada and in 1988, before becoming Lt. Governor, was even awarded the Prestigious ORDER OF CANADA, subsequently upgraded to Officer of the Order of Canada.

Duvet Comfort Inc. is famous for its down-filled coats and is a leader in fashion-meets-function outerwear. In 2008, the company launched its "Canadian Spirit" line with The M Coat, a coat specially designed for mothers-to-be. It is a unique convertible 3-in-1 jacket that converts from a fashionable Maternity coat to a hip Mama coat; and back to a regular fitting Myself coat. The innovative M Coat was showcased at the Babytime Show in Toronto and featured on Breakfast Television, Cityline, CTV, OMNI Television and SavvyMom Today. The company's

products are sold in leading retail stores including Sporting Life, Rhonda Maternity, EvyMaMa, My Bump, Andrews and Holt Renfrew. Their down coat for people in wheel chairs has won the DX Awards for Winter & Fashion Design and the company is now as one of Canada's 50 fastest growing companies.

### Best International Business Dr. Pui Ling Chan, SkyWave Mobile Communications



Founded in 1997, SkyWave Mobile Communications designs, manufactures and exports satellite terminals and is a global supplier of Inmarsat's D+/IsatM2M network satellite services.

Under Dr. Pui Ling Chan and his team, revenues have grown over 10 times and are still growing at 10% annually. SkyWave employs over 80 employees with its main operations in Ottawa and offices in Brazil, Mexico and Hong Kong. It operates its own D+/IsatM2M network over Inmarsat's international satellite constellation with satellite stations in New Zealand and the Netherlands. To-date, SkyWave has sold over 150,000 terminals and in 2008 alone, processed over 240 million messages! The company sells through a solid network of over 170 Solution Providers in more than 45 countries.



SkyWave's management is focused on staff training and development. It believes investment in its employees will help ensure future success of the company. In fact, it encourages top employees to attend Queen's University Executive Management program.

To help the community, SkyWave is a major supporter of a new gymnasium for an orphanage in Brazil. It and its employees also regularly make donations to many different charitable organizations such as the United Way and World Vision Canada. The company also offers co-op programs to students at Carlton University, University of Ottawa and University of Waterloo.
