In 1981 Dr. Vivienne Poy founded Vivienne Poy Mode and for the next fourteen years the firm enjoyed great success in fashion design, manufacturing and retail. She currently serves as the chair of Lee Tak Wai Holdings Ltd.

The list of her achievements and awards is long and wide-ranging. She was the first Canadian of Asian heritage to be appointed to the Senate of Canada. She also served as Chancellor of the University of Toronto from 2003 to 2006.

She has written several books including a biography in both Chinese and English of her father entitled Building Bridges: The Life and Times of Richard Charles Lee, Hong Kong, 1905- 1983.

In 2001 after the passage of a motion she had introduced, the Senate officially recognized May as Asian Heritage Month. Her many voluntary positions include being the Honorary Patron of the Chinese Cultural Centres of Greater Toronto and Greater Vancouver as well as the International Centre of Winnipeg.

She is also Honorary Advisor to the Buddhist Education Foundation for Canada and the Japanese Canadian Legacy Project.

In recognition of her services to expanding Canadian diversity and multiculturalism she has received a Gold Medal Award of Excellence in Race Relations, an Outstanding Asian Canadian Award from the Canadian Multicultural Council - Asians in Ontario and an Eid-ul-Fitr

Award from the Association of Progressive Muslims of Canada.

Academically, she has earned an Honours BA from McGill University and an MA and Ph.D. in history from the University of Toronto. Her U of T doctoral thesis focused on the immigration of generations of Chinese women to Canada. She also holds a Diploma in Fashion Arts from Seneca College.

She has been an active and generous philanthropic supporter of the University of Toronto. In honour of her parents, she has established the Richard Charles and Esther Yewpick Lee Chair in Chinese Thought and Culture at the Faculty of Arts and Science, the Richard Charles Lee Canada Hong Kong Library, the Vivienne Poy Endowment in Asian Canadian Cultural Studies and the Vivienne Poy Chancellor's Fellowship in the Humanities and Social Sciences.

Universities in Canada, the United States, Hong Kong, China and South Korea have conferred honorary degrees on her.

Born in Hong Kong just before the Japanese invasion, she and her family subsequently fled to safety in China. They returned to Hong Kong after the war where her father served as the government rice controller. His position involved importing and overseeing the fair distribution of that food staple to residents.

In 1959, after three years at a private girls' school in

England, she came to Canada and enrolled at McGill University to study history. That's where she met medical student and her future husband, Neville Poy. He is the elder brother of Adrienne Clarkson, former Governor-General and 2011 ACCE Lifetime Achievement award recipient.

The couple has three sons and three grandchildren.

ENTREPRENEUR of THE YEAR Award

Ms. Dawn Zhou, CSIT Group

Dawn Zhou immigrated to Saskatchewan with her family more than 25 years ago. Although she holds a Master's degree in geosciences, she was not able to find work in her field in Canada. As a result, Ms. Zhou obtained a Certified General Accountants license in order to support her family.

In 1993, she founded CSIT Consulting Inc., a company that has helped owner-managed companies reach their goals and become more successful.

In 2004, CSIT decided to invest in a number of start-up companies, including setting up and establishing an oil operation for a private overseas corporation. Soon thereafter, Ms. Zhou obtained valuable mineral property rights in Saskatchewan's resource basin.

A number of notable resource companies were created under Zhou's CSIT umbrella, including Athabasca Potash, which was sold to BHP for \$341 million dollars in 2010. The revenue for the CSIT group of companies was a staggering \$11 million in 2012.

Throughout her meteoric success, Zhou has maintained her core values of humility, a strong work ethic, and service to the community. She has served as President of the Chinese Students and Scholars Association for the University of Saskatchewan, President of the Chinese Cultural Society of Saskatchewan and made generous monetary donations every year to worthwhile causes in the Saskatchewan area and to scholarships for students of universities in China.

Ringo Chow is the founder of Evergo Packaging - an offset printing and packaging company that specializes in consumer packaging products. The company produces a variety of standard and custom packaging products and provides printing services for pharmaceuticals, retail, and beverage and bakery industries.

With its state-of-the art equipment using Computer to Plate (CTP) Systems, Evergo Packaging has developed and introduced many unique and innovative packaging products including tamper-evident design, anti-counterfeit, invisible ink, RFID, and covert watermarking.

In addition to being an ISO 9001:2008 certified company, Evergo Packaging has been recognized for its environmental initiatives involving energy-saving, recycling and waste reduction. It received the Agfa Environmental Recognition Award in 2007 and is also a member of the Forest Stewardship Council.

Dr. George Yee and his partners founded Medical Labs of Windsor in the late 1960's. He bought out his partners in the 1980's and proceeded to grow the business to become the largest medical diagnostic service laboratory in Windsor. Thousands of blood tests and urine samples now go through Medical Labs of Windsor's ten locations on a daily basis.

As his business flourished, Dr. Yee looked for ways to give back to his community. In the past 50 years, he has contributed monetarily to many great causes. Having grown up in Winnipeg, Manitoba, his largest donation was the sum of \$2.5 million dollars to launch the George and Fay Yee Centre for Healthcare Innovation in 2008.

Dr. Yee's charitable contributions have assisted many aspiring Canadian doctors. In memory of his mother, he established the Pauline Yee Harrison Medical Student Bursary at the University of Manitoba and endowed it with the sum of \$200,000. Dr. Yee also contributed \$95,000 to the University of Manitoba Class of 1960 Entrance Scholarship in Medicine and \$150,000 to the Ontario Medical Student Bursary Fund.

In 2011, Dr. Yee donated \$400,000 to the Winnipeg Chinatown Development Corporation's capital campaign to build assisted-living homes in Chinatown.
