### Lifetime Achievement Award Brigitte Shim, Shim-Sutcliffe Architects

Brigitte Shim is an architect, educator and unwavering advocate for design excellence. She and A. Howard Sutcliffe are the founding partners of Shim-Sutcliffe Architects, one of Canada's most innovative architectural practices, with an international reputation for masterful designs bringing together the elements of landscape, interiors, lighting and hardware.

Universally respected by architects, academics, students, and the general public, their work continually opens people's eyes to the beauty of architecture and how it resonates with nature. Their designs and structures explore the potential of natural light and its connection to the spiritual.

Brigitte hails from Jamaica and immigrated to Toronto, Canada, in 1965 with her parents. She later attended the University of Waterloo's School of Architecture.

## Entrepreneur of the Year Award

Today, Brigitte is also a professor at the John H. Daniels Faculty of Architecture, Landscape, and Design at the University of Toronto and is committed to educating the next generation of architects.

Her design studios always challenge her students to address issues that shape the future of our cities and environment. She has also been a visiting professor at many other renowned schools of architecture.

For several decades, Brigitte has generously given her time and energy to serving on many local, national and international design juries. She is on the advisory board for BEAT in Toronto, where she advocates for diversity and equity in the profession of architecture. She also serves on the Master Jury and subsequent steering committees for the Aga Khan Award for Architecture, a program celebrating outstanding global architecture.

To date, Brigitte and Howard have received sixteen Governor General's Medals for Architecture from the Royal Architectural Institute of Canada and an American Institute of Architects National Honor Award.

Oscar Fan and Daniel Wang wanted to make a difference in the world of computer technology waste. In 2005, they established Advanced Skyline Technology (AST) to do just that.

A large number of computers are assigned to electronic waste prematurely and then shipped overseas to third-world countries and disposed of improperly due to high costs.

AST developed a cost-effective, high-quality, innovative refurbishing technology with a high degree of automation, working with leading brands and making quality, refurbished, branded computers for low-budget businesses and users, such as schools, start-ups and lower-income families.

Rebecca Pang, Vice President, Commercial Financial Services, RBC Royal Bank, presented the Lifetime Achievement Award to Brigitte Shi Shim-Sutcliffe Architects.

In January 2013, Brigitte and Howard were awarded the Order of Canada "for their contributions as architects designing sophisticated structures that represent the best of Canadian design to the world." And in 2021, they were awarded the Royal Architectural Institute of Canada's Gold Medal, its highest honour.

Since its inception, AST has become North America's most competitive refurbished computer enterprise, with facilities in Canada and China. And with its continual growth, AST has been awarded the prestigious status of a Microsoft Gold Certified Partner.

AST also contributes to reducing our carbon footprint by lengthening the computer lifecycle, making it eligible to generate revenue-earning carbon credits.

It is also giving back to the community by donating refurbished computers to the Toronto District School Board and other Ontario school boards. During the pandemic, it donated five ambulance vehicles to Wuhan, China. AST regularly participates in various internship programs and hires co-op students to develop the next generation.

## Best International Business Award John Li, Sinobec Group Inc.

John Li has turned a one-man trading business into a multi-national corporation. He started working out of his basement, and today, his company, Sinobec Group, has made hundreds of millions in revenue dealing with green energy segments all over the world.

Before immigrating to Canada, John worked for China metals and minerals group. With more than 30 years' experience, he has grown his company rapidly across the world. Sinobec Group can efficiently supply a breadth of aluminum products to clients in various industries, including aviation, automobiles, marine, construction and green energy. It now has operations

on four continents and employs over 300 people worldwide, providing services to hundreds in Canada, China, Costa Rica, Germany, Indonesia, Turkey and the U.S.A., to name just a few.

Under his leadership, Sinobec Group Inc. was named one of Canada's Fastest-Growing Companies by Canadian Business magazine for two years in a row, 2019 and 2020. He also serves on the board of directors of the Canadian Chinese Entrepreneurs Council (CCEC). In addition, Sinobec Group Inc. was named the most influential Chinese Canadian-owned company in Quebec by CCEC in

Aaron Chin, the CEO of Organika Health Products, is a second-generation entrepreneur dedicated to expanding the company's mission to help people "Fall in Love with Living Healthy."

His father launched Organika in 1990, selling nutritional supplements from the back of his van. When Aaron grabbed the reins a few years ago with his brother Jordan, who serves as COO, the company had hit annual revenues of up to \$8 million.

The success of Organika was largely based on its sale of

broths. Organika employs a team of 140 and continues to do its own manufacturing in an effort to be more cost effective,

bringing in more than \$70 million in sales last year.

Aaron and his brother expanded Organika's product line to

include more superfoods, protein powders and bone

With the explosion of Asia's health product market, the company has been using Hong Kong as its gateway to Asia, shipping about 10% of its products to the territory. With an eye to further penetrating markets outside Canada, Aaron is aiming for \$100 million in revenue in the next few years.

## Best Community Service Award Yvonne Chan, Santé Circle Health

After having a serious accident at the age of 16, Yvonne Chan had a poor healthcare experience with her surgeons and physiotherapists. As a result, she decided to become a physiotherapist herself to provide better care to others.

Her national healthcare company, Santé Circle Health, provides occupational health and disability management services, and she has grown her reputation to become an industry-recognized expert in absence and disability management.

Yvonne has continuously given back to the community. Her national health programs are very inclusive, and her company has made commendable progress in including Indigenous care services. From 2014 to 2017, Yvonne was

part of the medical team for Aboriginal Affairs and Northern Development Canada, helping assess injuries of Indian residential school survivors.

Her understanding of reconciliation continued to develop, and today, she works with the organization Okimaw to develop Indigenous care services across Canada

Yvonne believes in and exemplifies servant leadership. She is the president of the Toronto Chapter of the Young Presidents' Organization and volunteers at Nonnina's Table, providing nourishment to members of the downtown Toronto community. She has a long history of serving the Chinese community in Scarborough and has contributed to improving rehabilitation care in Ontario.

# Best Start-up Award

Raymond Chik, Untether Al

Untether Al was developed by Martin Snelgrove, Darrick Wiebe and Raymond Chik in 2018. Untether Al's vision was to make Al processes run faster and cooler. Untether Al's at-memory compute architecture breaks through the computational bottleneck in Al efficiency.

The increased use of AI – along with its heavy computational needs and advanced hardware requirements – poses a challenge for traditional datacenter compute architectures.

Untether Al is creating an ultra-efficient neural processor which will allow small mobile devices (such as AR headsets and wearables) to carry out powerful inference operations (for example, machine vision and speech recognition capabilities).

Its chip technology can be used in a variety of spaces, including banking and financial services, natural language processing, autonomous vehicles, industrial robotics, smart cities, retail and other applications that require high-throughput and low-latency Al acceleration.

Untether AI may be setting a new bar in power efficiency, inference performance and latency of chip design, and it may offer significant opportunities in performance-demanding applications, particularly in self-driving vehicles and other automated operations.
